#### VCSQI Database Updates

Eddie Fonner, VCSQI Executive Director, reported updated figures from our STS and CathPCI databases, which contain over 200,000 patient records submitted by 17 cardiac surgery sites and 19 cardiology members. 17 programs are already uploading to the new STEMI database; next up is the TVT registry, where one program has loaded their cases and 8 more are in the queue.

#### Advances in Mitral and Tricuspid Therapies

Drs. Jason Foerst (Carilion), Eric Sarin (Inova), and Kenan Yount (UVA) comprised the evening's main event, where the three clinical leaders presented about new transcatheter and surgical options for valve patients.

An engaging roundtable discussion followed, including interactive polls to assess how audience members would elect to treat different patient scenarios.
